Representing Northern Ireland

Only fully paid up members of the UCPSA, who are in good standing can qualify to represent Northern Ireland at Home International Tournaments. While representing their country they **Must Compete** in the recognised Northern Ireland Team Vest.

The Northern Ireland Team Badge and members name above the front pocket and “Northern Ireland” on the back are the **only** things permitted on the shooting vest. Font size etc. as directed when receiving your vest.

Team managers are empowered to remove from the competition any team member in violation of these rules.

Northern Ireland Team Members must attend the Home International Photo Call and Banquet (unless under exceptional circumstances having obtained permission to be absent from the team Manager).

They must attend in the official Team Uniform supplied free of charge to all team members by the UCPSA and remain in it until the end of prize giving. Ladies are not permitted to wear skirts shorter than one inch (2.5cm) above the knee.

Any member who fails to abide by any of the above rules or fails to abide by any group instruction given by the Team Manager will be barred from representing Northern Ireland for a period of two years.

Any member who has applied to be considered for International Team Selection and, having been appointed to a place on a team, fails to give adequate notice of withdrawal from the team without a reason acceptable to the board of the UCPSA will be liable to suspension from future team events which may include Home International and World events.

Furthermore members must sign off their intention to attend an International event on or before the cut off or sign off date. Signing off should be registered with the Team Manager or the Administration Secretary.

2021 National Team Selection.

Scores shot within Northern Ireland for Northern Ireland team selection, Ulster Cups or UCPSA Classifications can only be taken from the specified shoots listed in the year book or published by the Board on the Associations website

www.ucpsa.com Shoot entry must be made under UCPSA membership number.

Under no circumstances can scores be taken from any other events.

** Where the individual discipline selection procedure permits, up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland. Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void.

UCPSA affiliated clubs in Northern Ireland are not permitted to run events for any other association or organisation without the prior written approval of the Board.

There will be no exceptions to any of the above rules.

UCPSA- NSCA World Sporting 2021 Team Selection Procedure

The top five Seniors - 3 Juniors - 3 Ladies - 3 Veterans - 3 Super Veterans on the 2019 Home International Leader Board who have signed off with the Team Manager Trevor Wilson on or before the 4th January 2020 of their intention to attend the event at EJ Churchill's /10th 11th July 2021.

HCIT Team Selection English Sporting 2021

Points taken from UCPSA Registered Shoots

20 points for highest score in all categories for UCPSA members who have completed the Team Application form. Team Selection will be determined by ranking the highest total achieved from the sum of a possible maximum of 6 sets of points from different grounds. One set of points from 18th July to 31st December 2020 can be counted towards the 2021 team.

Ties will be decided on count back i.e. shooter scoring 20 points beats shooter scoring 19 points, in the event of a tie remaining then the next counting score from a different ground will be used.

Members must sign off their intention to take up their team place if selected for the Home International Team on or before the end of the shoot on the cut-off date for Home International 24th July 2021.

FITASC Sporting Team Selection Procedure 2021

Points taken from UCPSA Registered Shoots

FITASC Sporting team selection will be determined by ranking the highest total achieved from up to 3 sets of points. 12 points for highest score in all categories for UCPSA members who have completed the Team Application form. One set of points from 18th July to 31st December 2020 can be counted towards the 2021 team.

Ties will be decided on count back e.g. shooter scoring 12 points beats shooter scoring 11 points, in the event of a tie remaining then the next counting score from a different ground will be used. Members must sign off their intention to take up their team place if selected for the Home International Team on or before the end of the shoot on the cut-off date for Home International 21st August 2021.

The Governing body for Clay Target Shooting in Northern Ireland **Automatic Ball Trap Team Selection Procedure 2021**

Best 5 Scores to count from UCPSA Registered shoots. No more than 2 scores from any one ground, 3 scores can be counted towards the 2021 team from 18th July - 31st Dec 2020. No more than 2 scores from non UCPSA shoots (see note below**).

Team Cut Off for Home International is 21st August 2021.

Up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland. Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void.

DTL Team Selection Procedure 2021

Best 6 scores from UCPSA registered shoot, no more than 2 scores from any one ground, no more than 2 scores from non UCPSA shoots (see note below**). 3 scores from 18th July - 31st December 2020 can be counted towards the 2021 team. Also must count 3 out of 5 UCPSA compulsory shoots.

Juniors best 6 scores from UCPSA registered shoots no restriction on number from any ground. Also must count 3 out of 4 compulsory shoots. Cut off for Home International 26th June 2021 (Selection applies to Home International and Europeans).

Up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland. Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void

National Skeet Team Selection Procedure 2021

Best 6 scores to count from UCPSA registered shoots, no more than 2 scores from any one ground, no more than 2 scores from non UCPSA shoots, (see note below**). 3 scores from 18th July - 31st Dec 2020 can be counted towards the 2021 team. Top placed L/J/V/SV must take team place. However any L/J/V/SV who does not qualify can qualify for senior team providing their scores place them in the top 10 on the senior leader board Team Cut Off for Home International is 7th August 2021.

Junior Team Selection Best 4 Scores.

Up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland. Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void.

The Governing body for Clay Target Shooting in Northern Ireland **Olympic Skeet Team Selection Procedure 2021**

Best 4 scores to count from UCPSA registered shoots, no more than 2 scores from non UCPSA shoots (see note below**). 125 bird shoots - score taken from 1st 100. Either day of 200 can count. One score from 18th July to 31st December 2020 can be counted towards the 2021 team. Top placed L/J/V/SV must take team place. However, those L/J/V/SV who do not qualify can qualify for senior team providing their scores place them in the top 9 on the Senior leader board. Team Cut off 31st July 2021.

Up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void.

Olympic Trap Team Selection Procedure 2021

Best 4 scores to count from UCPSA registered shoots from September 2019. No more than 1 score from non UCPSA shoots (see note below**) Either day of 200 target competition can count. Top placed L/J/V/SV who do not qualify in their own category can qualify for Senior Team providing their scores place them in the top 9 on the Senior Leader Board. Cut Off for Home International is 24th July 2021.

Up to a maximum of 2 scores may be used from non UCPSA shoots which must be outside of Northern Ireland. Those wishing to do so must first obtain a UCPSA form from their Discipline Representative* or the above web site, have it completed by the event organizer or secretary and return it to the UCPSA Statistical Officer* within seven days of the event.

Failure to return the correct form properly completed on time will result in the score being void
