

Compulsory Selection Shoot Policy

Where a discipline holds compulsory selection shoots every effort should be made by those seeking selection to attend these shoots.

The compulsory shoots will normally take the form of e.g. "counting three from four"; this is intended so that members who are unable to attend one of these shoots can still shoot the required number of compulsory shoots.

Where a member cannot attend a compulsory shoot they may apply via their discipline representative to the Board to be exempted from that shoot and have another shoot in the future substituted.

The Board will exercise very strict criteria when considering an application, below are the most likely circumstances to warrant an exemption:

- the death or funeral of a close family member.
- ill health and providing medical evidence is forwarded with application.
- representing the Association of essential nature.

Any exemption is at the discretion of the Board who will consult with the discipline rep and may allocate another event as a replacement for the compulsory providing there is sufficient time within the calendar.
