Northern Ireland Commonwealth Games Application Form Olympic Trap - Commonwealth Games 2026

The following criteria will be used to nominate athletes to the Northern Ireland Commonwealth Games Council for selection for the 2026 Commonwealth Games:

1. Scores may be recorded from either 125 or 200 target competitions in Northern Ireland or elsewhere (see note below).
2. Competitors must submit selected events outside Northern Ireland in writing to the board for approval, minimum of one week prior to the event occurring.

The board will consider if the event is of a significant nature to be considered for MCS (minimum counting score). Only events deemed significant by the board will be approved for recording MCS.

MCS are: **Trap Men** - 114ex125 / 182ex200 **Trap Women** - 107ex125 / 171ex200

Important notes:

- The individual shall be deemed to have made him/herself familiar with, and hereby agrees to be bound by, the UK Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping and any other appropriate body in the application and enforcement of those Rules.
- The individual agrees to cooperate fully with any World Anti-Doping Code compliant anti-doping investigations or proceedings, whether conducted by UK Anti-Doping or any Other Competent Body.
- This form acts as a contract between you and the UCPSA. In signing this form, you agree to abide by the UCPSA's Rules, as published on the website, for attending high level events.
